INTERNATIONAL LIED MASTERCLASSES

for duos voice & piano 2010 - 2011

In 2000 Udo Reinemann started the International Lied Masterclasses for advanced singers and pianists. These masterclasses, taught by Udo Reinemann himself as well as internationally renowned singers and pianists of song repertoire, form since 2007 a special part of the singing programme at the Koninklijk Conservatorium Brussel. The masterclasses are open to advanced KCB students as well as students with a professional level from other conservatoires and countries and also for young professional duos. Participation is free for KCB students. All other participants pay a fee of € 1200 per duo for the entire masterclass programme. It is not possible to apply for a single class; all participants will follow the entire programme. Participants will receive a certificate. The participants will give two recitals at the Concertzaal, on thursday April 7.

Candidates may apply by sending in the application form or - preferably - via the website: www.kcb.be. Application forms have to be sent in by May 10, 2010, at the latest. Candidates will audition on Friday May 28 from 14.00 to 20.00 p.m. at the Koninklijk Conservatorium Brussel. Participants from abroad are also required to audition, only in exceptional cases candidates may send a recording (this can be tape as well as cd), together with a curriculum vitae and a photograph.
